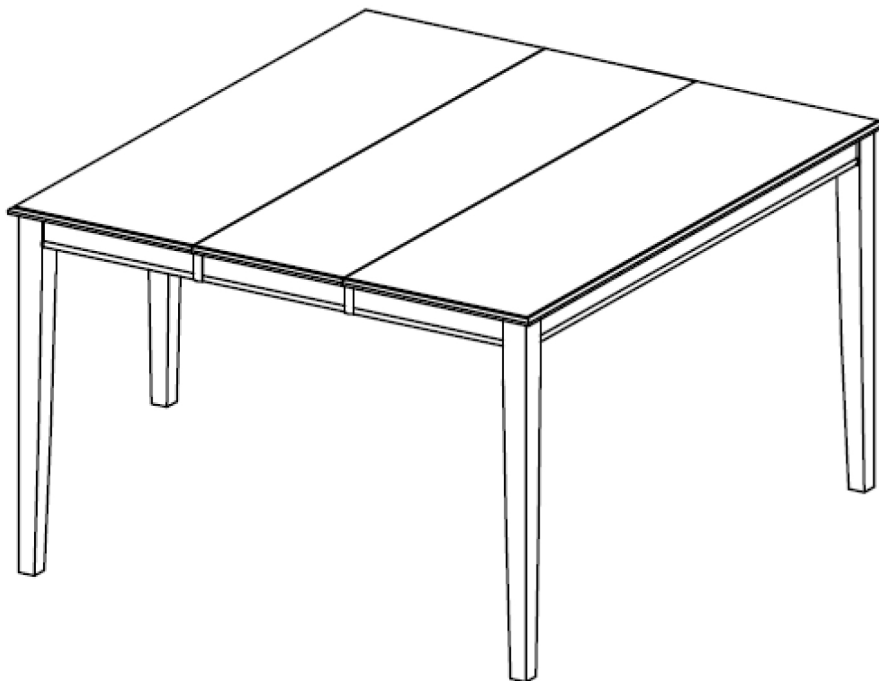


Assembly Instructions



ASSEMBLY RATING

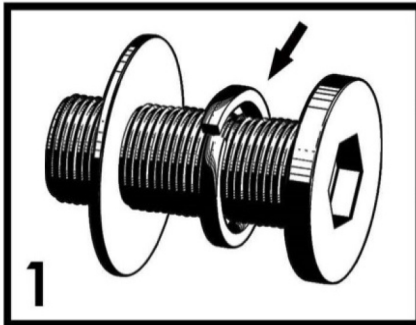

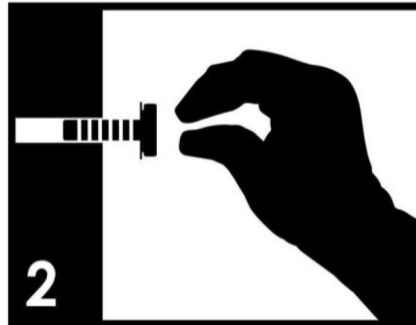

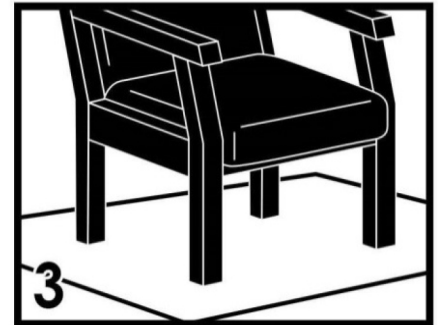
BASIC ASSEMBLY TECHNIQUES



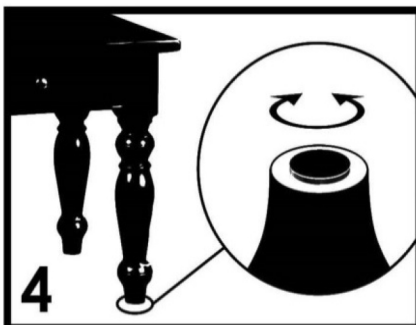
When lock or spring washer is used in an assembly, please make sure the lock or spring washer is placed between the larger flat washer and the head of the screw or bolt.



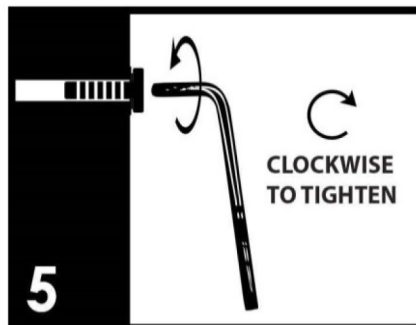
Position each part correctly and insert screws or bolts into their respective holes by hand tighten or using the proper hand tool. Only tighten when step is completed or when instructed to do so.



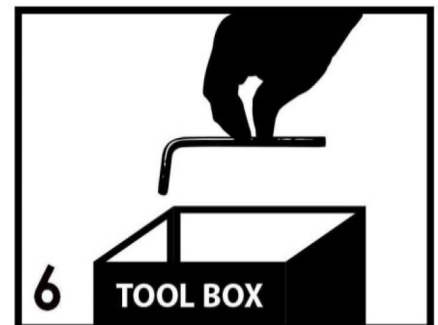
Use cardboard or carpet area when assembling furniture to prevent scratches. Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.



Some furniture comes with height adjustment knobs underneath each leg. To lower or to raise each leg, you need to turn clockwise or counterclockwise, respectively.



Make sure all parts are properly aligned, then use the appropriate hand tool to completely tighten the bolts or screws. Do not use power tools and do not overtighten.

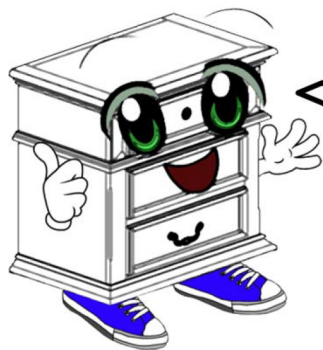


Save the instructions and store the Allen wrench or any supplied tool for later maintenance. After two weeks, check and tighten any loose hardware and repeat again every six months thereafter.

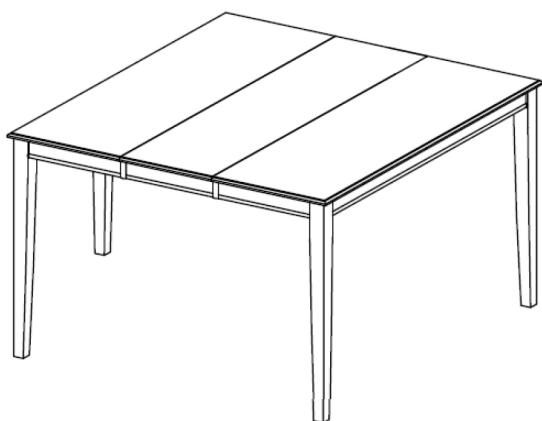

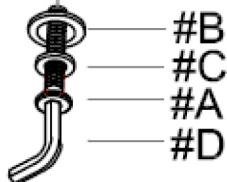
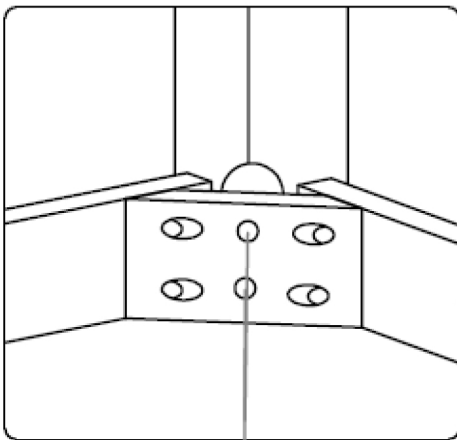


Due to the size and/or weight of this product, it is highly recommended that the assembly should be done near the area of its intended location. Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly. ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid any potential injury and/or damage.

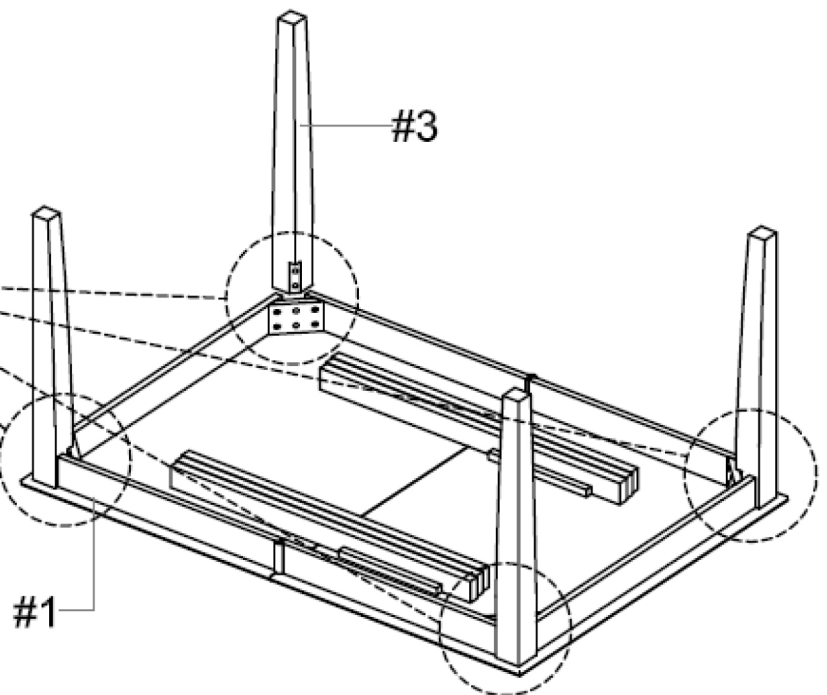


- I. With the help of another person, carefully place the table top (#1) facing down on a protected surface.
- II. Align the 4 legs (#3) with the pre-drilled holes on the bottom corners of the table top (#1).
- III. Prepare 8 bolt assemblies by inserting FIRST the lock washer (#C) onto the bolt (#A) and then the flat washer (#B) onto the SAME bolt (#A), in that order.
- IV. Insert the bolt assemblies through the pre-drilled holes on the bottom corners of the table top (#1) and secure those bolts using the Allen wrench (#D) to lock them with the legs (#3).
- V. Carefully turn the completed table upright. Make sure the table is rested on a flat surface and it does not feel loose or wobbly. If it does, double check that the bolts are secured and properly tighten.

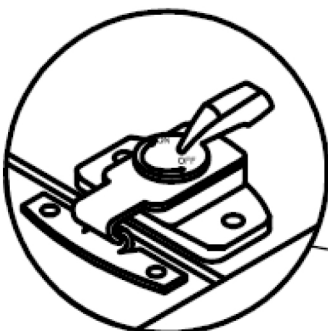
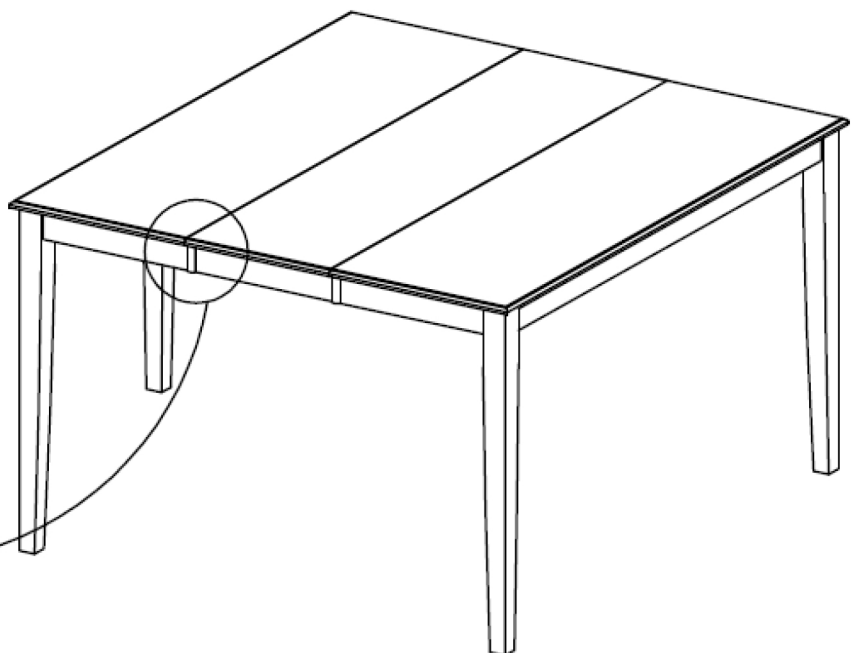
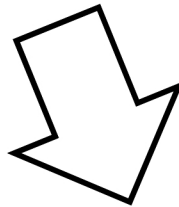
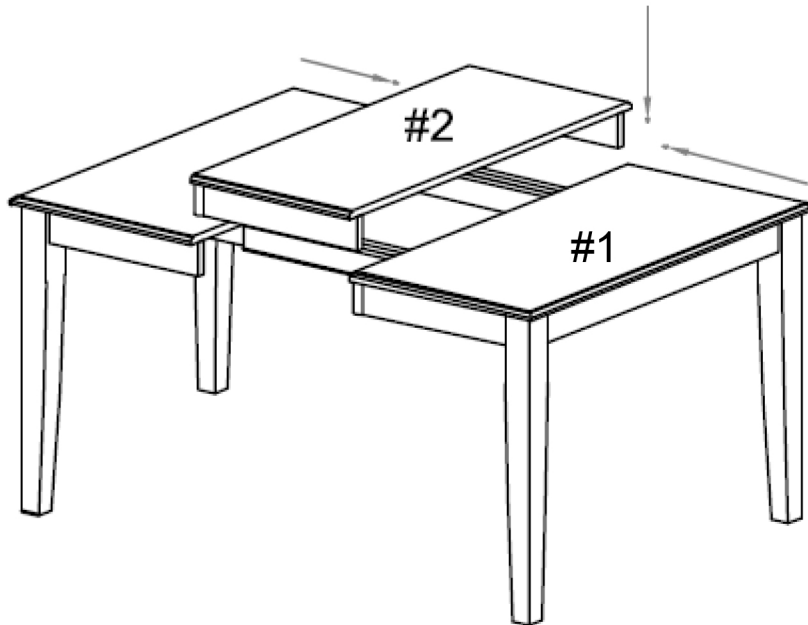


Turn right (clockwise) to tighten



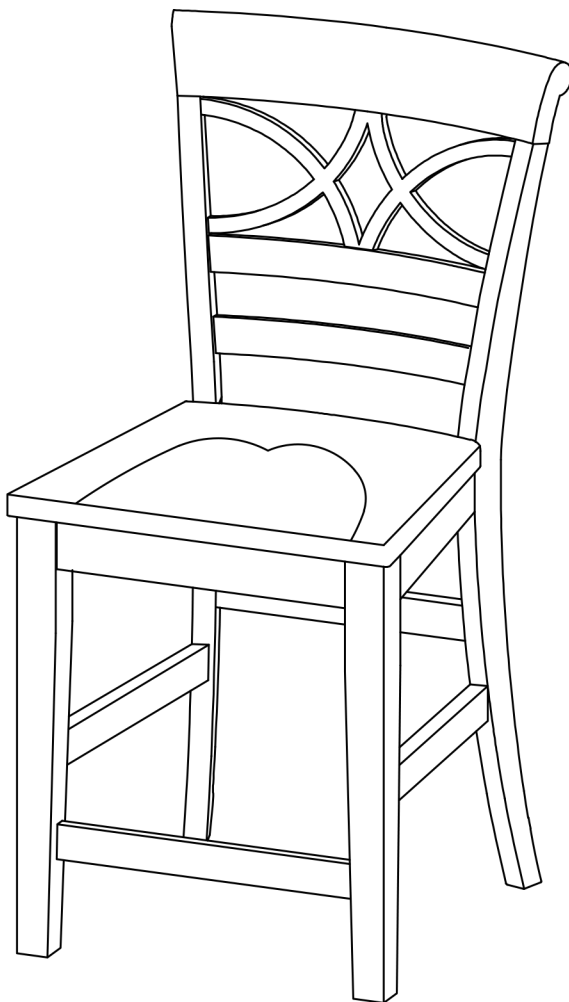


- I. To insert the leaf (#2) unlock the latches located under the table.
- II. Once unlocked, slide outward on both ends of the outer two-piece table top (#1) until there is sufficient opening to place the leaf (#2). Then slide inward on both ends of the outer two-piece table top (#1) until they are touching and sitting flush with the leaf (#2).
- III. Secure the parts together by locking the latches located under the table.

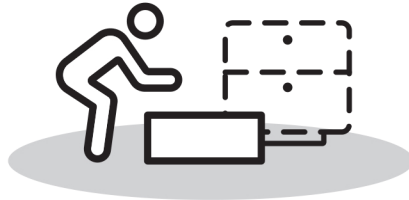
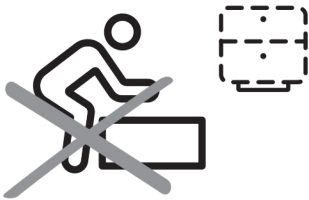
PRE ASSEMBLY INTRODUCTION

We understand building ready-to-assemble furniture can be a challenging experience for some. To help avoid confusion, we have provided some helpful tips that may speed up the process.



Teamwork

ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.



Suitable Location

Assembling near the area of the intended location is highly recommended.



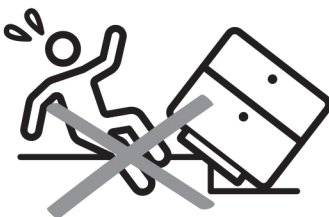
Sufficient Space

Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.



Avoid Scratches

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent scratches.



Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

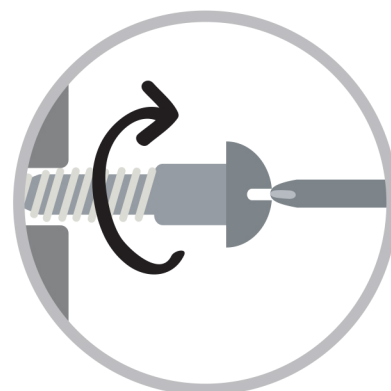

Exploded View

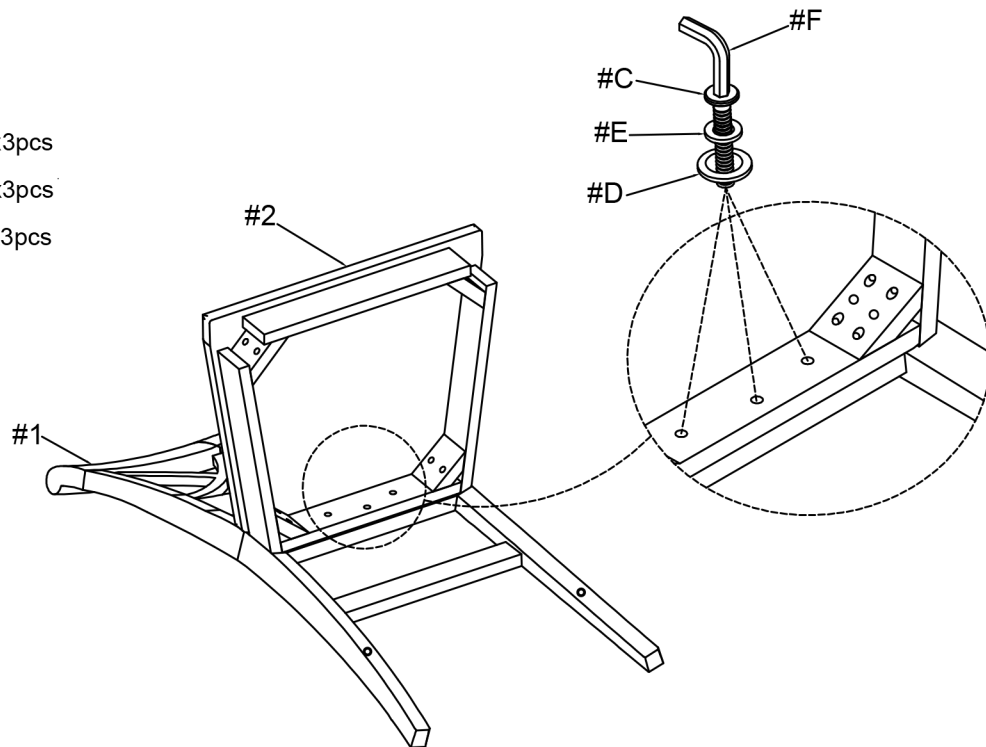

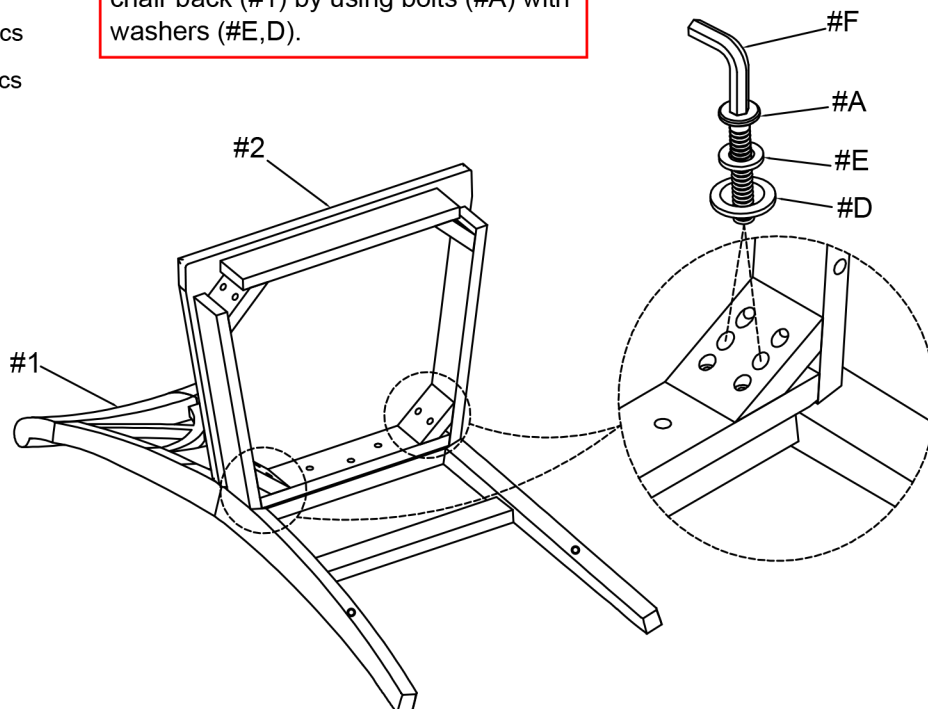
Align seat (#2) to chair back (#1), then secure by using bolts (#C) with washers (#E,D).

Hardware #A x4pcs

Secure corner holes of the seat (#2) to chair back (#1) by using bolts (#A) with washers (#E,D).

Align legs (#3R/L) with stretchers (#4,5R/L) to the chair, then secure legs (#3R/L) to seat by using bolts (#B) with washers (#E,D).

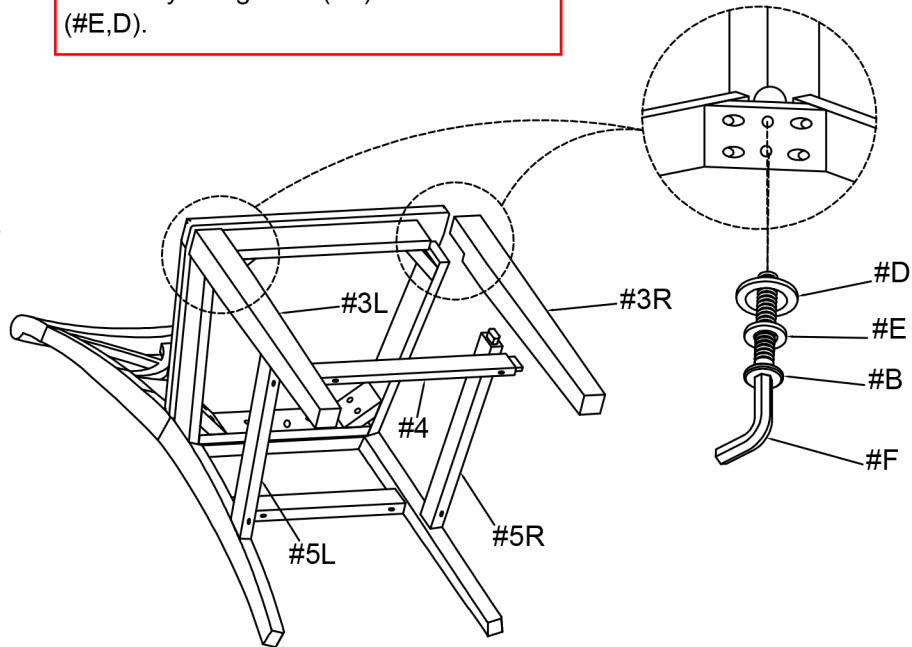

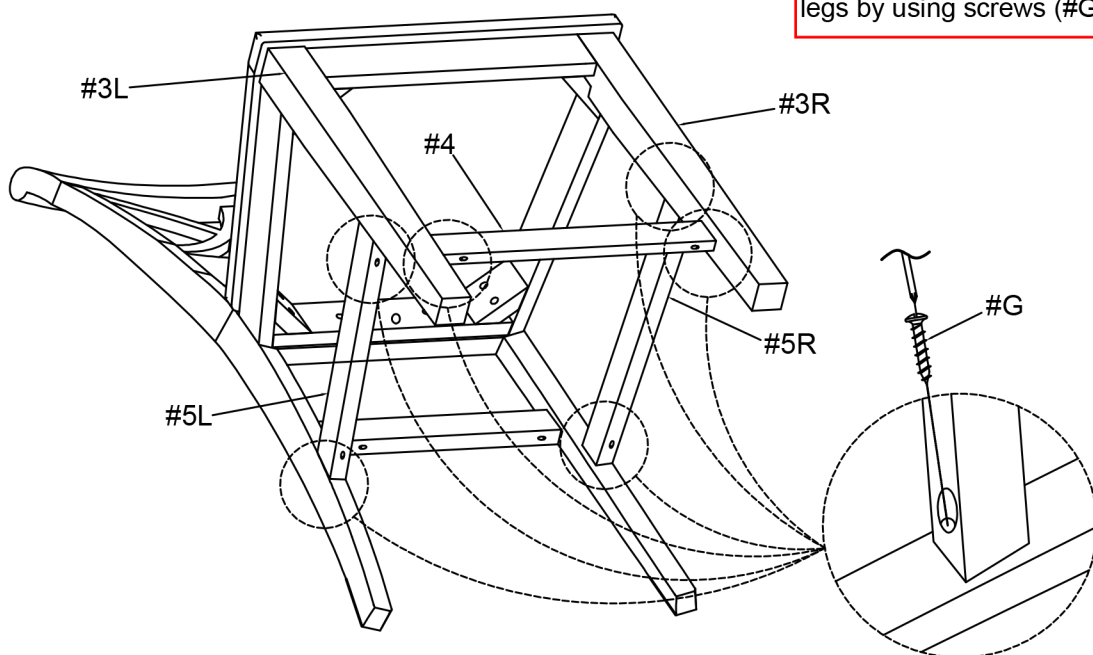

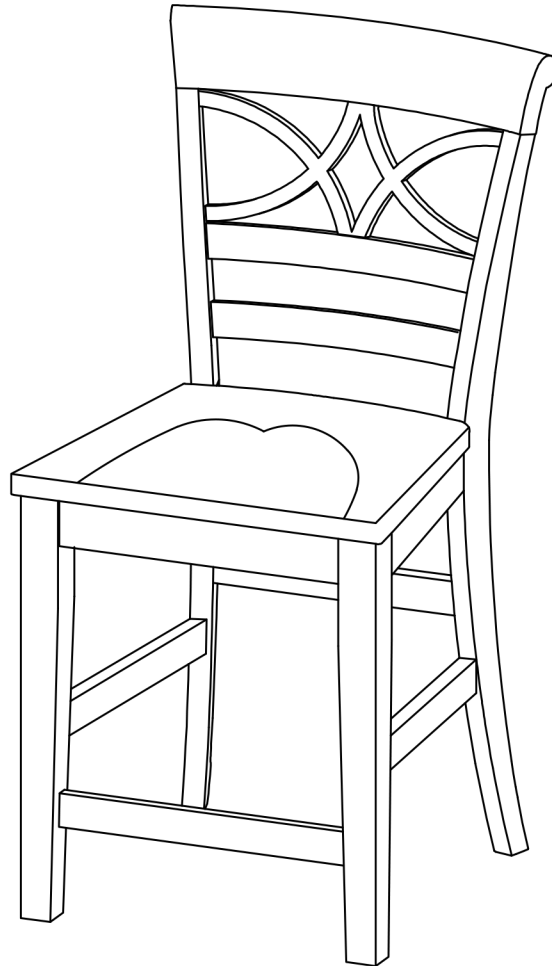
